G-STAR SCHOOL GRADUATES 99% OF STUDENTS IN 2010!

The numbers are in, and the G-Star School of the Arts for Motion Pictures and Broadcasting (a charter high school in Palm Springs, Florida) has turned in a stunning performance for the school year 2009-2010. AMERICAN MUSIC FESTIVAL IN DAYTONA BEACH PRESENTS BUDDY GUY AND TAJ MAHAL W/ THE PHANTOM BLUES BAND

The American Music Festival (<http://www.amf2010.com/>) is a four day Labor Day Extravaganza from September 1st-5th that will feature performances from iconic artists on the stages of the Bandshell, Ocean Center and Peabody Auditorium. Regional artists and local favorites will also take the stage at community stages located on the festival campus.

Any discussion of [Buddy Guy](#), blues legendary icon, invariably involves a recitation of his colossal musical resume and hard-earned accolades and awards. The Phantom Blues Band was originally formed as a backup band to Taj Mahal on album, "Dancin' the Blues." The members of the band have backed and recorded with many blues greats including: B.B. King, Buddy Guy, Otis Rush and Jimmy Reed. Legendary on their own, they will perform with these two blues giants on one stage.
